

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH FRONTENAC**

**BY-LAW #44-09**

**BEING A BY-LAW TO REPEAL BY-LAW #23-98 AND TO ESTABLISH LOAD RESTRICTIONS ON ROADWAYS IN NORTH FRONTENAC TOWNSHIP;**

**WHEREAS** Section 122 subsection 7 of the *Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990 c.H8*, as amended provides that the municipal corporation or other authority having jurisdiction over a roadway may by by-law designate the date on which a reduced load period shall start or end and the roadway or portion thereof is jurisdiction to which the designation applies;

**AND WHEREAS** the reduced load period is deemed necessary for the protection of certain roadways in the Township of North Frontenac;

**THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Frontenac enacts as follows:

**THAT** By-law #23-98, being a By-law to establish load restrictions on roadways in the Township of North Frontenac is hereby repealed in its entirety;

**AND THAT** the provisions of subsection 1, 2, 3, and 4 of Section 122 of the *Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990 c.H8*, as amended apply to all roads within North Frontenac Township during the period from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of March to the 15<sup>th</sup> day of May inclusive each and every year, or at the discretion of the Public Works Manager (depending on weather conditions).

**AND THAT** any person violating the provisions of this by-law shall be subject to the penalties provided in Section 125 of the *Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990 c.H8*, as amended, and all such penalties shall be recoverable under the *Provincial Offences Act*.

**AND THAT** this by-law shall not become effective until appropriate signs have been erected in accordance with the regulations under the *Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.H8*, as amended.

**AND THAT** all resolutions, by-laws or parts of by-laws which are contrary to or inconsistent with this by-law are hereby repealed.

**AND THAT** this by-law shall take effect immediately upon the passing hereof.

READ a first and second time this 14<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2009.

READ a third time and finally passed this 14<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2009.
