Proposed Amendment to the Township's Fees and Charges By-law

The purpose of amending the Fees and Charges By-law to include the proposed fees is to initiate a new rink board advertising sponsorships program at the Plevna Outdoor Rink located at 6598 Buckshot Lake Road, Plevna, Ontario.

Sponsors can purchase advertising space on the rink boards at the Plevna Rink, with the required fee covering the cost of the advertising (creating artwork and placing on rink boards), plus contributing towards the rink project and future upgrades.

Proposed Fees for Rink Board Advertising

- 48" w x 34" h: \$650 year one, and annual renewal (May 1st annually) (if chosen by the sponsor) at a cost of \$400.
- 96" w x 34" h = \$1,000 year one, and annual renewal (May 1st annually) (if chosen by the sponsor) at a cost of \$600.
