

BY-LAW NO. 2014-39

of

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH FRONTENAC

Being a by-law to delegate authority to the Chief Administrative Officer, Treasurer and Deputy Treasurer

WHEREAS Section 23.1 of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended* (the Act) provides that without limiting sections 9, 10 and 11 of the Act, those sections authorize a municipality to delegate its powers and duties under this or any other Act to a person or body subject to the restrictions set out in this Part;

AND WHEREAS The Council of the Township of South Frontenac adopted By-law 2007-81 on the 20th day of November 2007, being a by-law to adopt a delegation of authority policy as per Section 270(1) of the Act;

AND WHEREAS Section 5(i) of By-law 2007-81 states that all delegations of Council powers, duties or functions shall be by by-law;

AND WHEREAS Sections 357, 358 and 359 of the Municipal Act allows the Council of the Township of South Frontenac to rectify or adjust assessment changes that have been received through section 357/358/359 applications and that Council deems it appropriate for these adjustments to be reviewed and approved through a delegated authority except where a request is received under section 357(1)(d.1);

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of South Frontenac deems it expedient to enact as follows:

1. That the Chief Administrative Officer, Treasurer and Deputy Treasurer be delegated the authority to review and approve applications and requests received under Sections 357/358/359 of the Municipal Act except for applications under section 357(1)(d.1).
2. That accountability and the transparency of the delegate's actions shall be to the Council of the Township of South Frontenac.
3. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of final passing.

READ A FIRST AND SECOND TIME this 17th day of June 2014.

READ A THIRD TIME, SIGNED, SEALED AND FINALLY PASSED this 17th day of June, 2014.
