

TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH FRONTENAC

BY-LAW NUMBER 2016-11

BEING A BY-LAW TO STOP UP, CLOSE AND SELL PORTIONS OF UNOPENED ROAD ALLOWANCES BETWEEN CONCESSIONS IX AND X AND BETWEEN LOTS 30 AND 31, BEDFORD DISTRICT: MAHMUD

WHEREAS, the Municipal Council of the Township of South Frontenac may pass a by-law to stop up, close and sell any highway or part thereof pursuant to the Municipal Act, section 34(1):

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the Township of South Frontenac's Notice By-law No. 2002-92, the Corporation of the Township of South Frontenac caused to be advertised the proposal to close the said road allowances:

AND WHEREAS the said road allowances are not used as a publically travelled roads:

AND WHEREAS no objections have been received to the road closings:

NOW THEREFORE THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH FRONTENAC BY ITS COUNCIL, HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. **THAT** the portions of road allowances lying between Concessions IX and X and between Lots 30 and 31, in the District of Bedford, identified as Part 1 and Part 3 of Plan 13R-21244, shown on Schedule 1, attached hereto and forming part of this by-law, shall be stopped up and closed and ownership transferred to the abutting property-owner on the west and on the north.
2. **THAT** the Mayor and Clerk/Administrator are hereby authorized and directed to execute such documents as are required; and
3. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and take effect upon registration of this By-law.
