

**TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH FRONTENAC
BY-LAW 2023-29**

**A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 2015-41, "A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT AND
REGULATE NOISE WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH FRONTENAC"**

WHEREAS Council desires to update By-law 2015-41;

NOW THEREFORE the Corporation of the Township of South Frontenac enacts as follows:

1. By-law 2015-41, As Amended, "A By-law to Prohibit and Regulate Noise Within the Township of South Frontenac", is hereby amended as follows:

That a new Section 2. regarding Responsibility of Property Owner be inserted in the By-law to read as follows:

"Responsibility of Property Owner

2. Every owner of property and every officer or director of a corporation that owns property within the Township of South Frontenac has a duty to take all reasonable care to prevent occupants and users of their property from breaching the provisions of this By-law;
 - (a) Every person who has a duty under this section and who fails to carry out that duty is guilty of an offence.
 - (b) A director or officer of a corporation is liable to a conviction under this section whether or not the corporation has been prosecuted or convicted."

That the remaining By-law sections be renumbered thereafter; and

Section 5. (formerly Section 4.) is amended by adding Clauses ii., iii. and iv., to read as follows:

- "ii. Any person may submit a Noise By-law Exemption Request Application up to four weeks in advance of the event to the Clerk's Department requesting an exemption from any of the prohibitions described in the General Prohibitions Section of the By-law;
- iii. Council approved exemptions will be in effect for the dates and times specified, and Council may impose any conditions that it considers appropriate; and
- iv. A Council approved exemption shall be invalid if these conditions are contravened."

2. This By-law will come into force and take effect on the date of its passing.
